**Synopsis:**

On 3/18/22 at 1111 hours, Captain Hennessy and I responded to Western Coventry Elementary (4588 Flat River Road) to meet the school principal to assist with an investigation.

**Main Narrative:**

Upon arrival, I was met by the school principal, \_\_\_\_\_ and the \_\_\_\_\_. They advised that an incident was brought to their attention when three siblings/students, \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_ were dropped off at school.

I spoke with the staff member, \_\_\_\_\_, who initially made contact with the siblings and their mother, \_\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ advised that on 3/18/22 at 8:50AM \_\_\_\_\_ informed her that his father, Daniel Dolan, picked him up by his neck and threw him outside. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that \_\_\_\_\_ informed her that \_\_\_\_\_ was present during the incident. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that \_\_\_\_\_ also confirmed what happened between \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ advised that \_\_\_\_\_ also told her that \_\_\_\_\_ threw something at \_\_\_\_\_ car windshield, causing damage. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that \_\_\_\_\_ appeared to be very red in the face and was lacking emotion, which was not consistent with her normal behavior. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that \_\_\_\_\_ did not respond to the statements provided by \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ and proceeded to leave the school. \_\_\_\_\_ later provided a written statement in regards to the incident.

I then spoke with \_\_\_\_\_ who advised \_\_\_\_\_ reported that Daniel picked him up by the neck and threw him. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that she was told Daniel then threw a toy at the windshield of \_\_\_\_\_ car, cracking it. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that she then spoke with \_\_\_\_\_ who told her \_\_\_\_\_ was very upset that the windshield was broken. \_\_\_\_\_ told \_\_\_\_\_ that she did not see Daniel grab \_\_\_\_\_ by the neck as she was in the van, but told her what occurred. \_\_\_\_\_ was in the vehicle when the object was thrown at the windshield and she disclosed additional concerning information from the past that was relayed to DCYF. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that she then spoke to \_\_\_\_\_ who also stated she did not see Daniel grab \_\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that \_\_\_\_\_ was also inside the vehicle when Daniel threw the object, which hit the windshield and cracked it. \_\_\_\_\_ further stated that \_\_\_\_\_ reported prior to leaving the residence Daniel slapped her across the face because she was crying. \_\_\_\_\_ advised that \_\_\_\_\_ also disclosed additional concerning information that was reported to DCYF. While speaking further with \_\_\_\_\_ she advised that there was visible redness on \_\_\_\_\_ cheek while she was speaking with her, consistent with her statement. \_\_\_\_\_ later provided a written statement.

After speaking with \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ it was decided that Off. Green and I would do a well-being check on \_\_\_\_\_ at the residence (4 Field of Dreams Drive), while Captain Hennessy and Off. Iannelli remained in close proximity of the residence. Upon arrival, I observed \_\_\_\_\_ in the far garden behind the residence. Initially we were unable to locate Daniel but he then came out of the area located near the chicken coup. I spoke with \_\_\_\_\_ while Off. Green remained with Daniel. At first, due to Daniel being in close proximity of \_\_\_\_\_, it was clear that she was reluctant to speak with us. I then pulled \_\_\_\_\_ further away from Daniel and I observed tears forming in \_\_\_\_\_ eyes. I told \_\_\_\_\_ that the school reported an incident to us that occurred at the residence and wanted to get her side of the story. \_\_\_\_\_ advised that they were running late for school and Daniel became upset, which started an argument. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that as \_\_\_\_\_ was leaving the residence he stopped for a second near the door. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that this upset Daniel and he grabbed him and pushed him through the door. \_\_\_\_\_ told Daniel that he did not need to handle the situation in that way and Daniel became more enraged. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that her and the children then got into the van as she and Daniel continued to argue. Once inside the van

she told her daughters what happened with . . . stated that while the four of them were in the van Daniel threw an item, which was identified as a plastic yellow toy truck, which struck the windshield and cracked it. . . stated that she left the residence and took the kids to school. . . stated she knew the children would report the incident to their teachers when they arrived. . . advised that she returned to the residence a short time later and her and Daniel had not spoken as she feared it would create another argument. As I spoke further with . . . she advised that she is in fear of Daniel and his behavior of late has been erratic, however, she did not want to see him arrested. . . stated that she has requested he go to speak with someone at the VA for his . . . but he has not gone to do so and does not plan to do so.

I then spoke to Daniel who did confirm what the children and . . . stated. Daniel stated that he was upset the children were going to be late for school and an argument occurred between he and . . . During the course of the argument Daniel stated that in an attempt to rush . . . outside so he wouldn't be late he did shove him out the door. Daniel admitted to throwing an object from the front steps towards the vehicle, however, he stated he did not mean for it to hit the vehicle or cause any damage.

It should be noted that while speaking with both parties I observed the windshield to be cracked, corroborating the stories provided by all parties involved.

At this time, Captain Hennessy was relayed the facts provided from the children and by both . . . and Daniel on scene. I also informed Captain Hennessy about the damage to the windshield, which was consistent with their stories. It was at this time that Captain Hennessy advised he did not believe an arrest on Daniel was warranted and we cleared. Upon further review, it was determined that the best course of action would be to draft a warrant and present it to a Justice of the Peace for a review of the facts and circumstances.

A warrant was then prepared (22-21-WA) for Daniel for Domestic - Vandalism/Malicious Injury to Property (RIGL 11-44-1/A) and Domestic Disorderly Conduct (RIGL 11-45-1/A). Upon its completion, I responded to the residence of the on-call Justice of the Peace, where the warrant was reviewed and signed at approximately 1945 hours.

**Damaged Items:**

The middle of the front windshield was cracked and spidered toward to the top and bottom.

**DCYF:**

At 1800 hours, I contacted DCYF (1-800-RI-CHILD) and spoke with Case Worker . . . I informed Case Worker . . . of the incident and later faxed a copy of the report to her.

**Additional Information:**

Investigation may continue dependent upon any information received from DCYF.
