LEGISLATION TO SUPPORT

Enforcement of Lead Hazard Mitigation Act

- Attorney General Peter Neronha introduced a legislative package that would force compliance with existing lead
 poisoning prevention laws that are already on the books and, when followed, protect children from the dangers of
 lead poisoning.
 - SB804 and HB6239 Sponsored by Senator Euer and Representative Ackerman
 - SB729 and HB6238: Sponsored by Senator Mack and Representative Morales
 - SB739 and HB6201: Sponsored by Senator Lawson and Representative Dawson

Lead Water Supply Replacement Program

- Legislation to establish a lead water supply replacement program and require disclosure of the presence of lead service lines to tenants and buyers of real property.
 - SB2 and HB5007: Sponsored by Senate President Ruggerio and Representative O'Brien
 - HB5318: Sponsored by Representative Morales

Expanding Protections of the Lead Hazard Mitigation Act

- Legislation would expand the protections of the Lead Hazard Mitigation Act to encompass dwellings with 2 or 3 units where one unit is owner-occupied
 - SB656 and HB5946: Sponsored by Senator Acosta and Representative Voas
