

Affidavit

Rhode Island Attorney General/Open Government Complaint (Open Meetings Act), including, but not limited to, use in any legal forum deeming it admissible as evidence

In re: Fagnoli v. City of Pawtucket/Pawtucket Charter Review Commission

I, David C Fagnoli, hereby make this sworn affidavit and state that:

1. I, on August 3, 2023, did compose and send an email, as public outreach, to Tracey Giron, who is/was the email contact provided by the City of Pawtucket for the Pawtucket Charter Review Commission.
2. I, on August 4, 2023, did receive an email reply, from Ms. Giron, confirming her receipt of my, David C Fagnoli, August 3, 2023 email, which also states that my, David C Fagnoli, email would be passed along to the Chair of the Charter Review Commission.
3. I was present, in person, for the Pawtucket Charter Review Commission meeting on August 8, 2023 to ensure receipt of my, David C Fagnoli, August 3, 2023 email outreach of concern was acknowledged by the Pawtucket Charter Review Commission as other emails of outreach/concern have been at previous Pawtucket Charter Review Commission meetings during 2023 meetings, or to be allowed to read my, David C Fagnoli, August 3, 2023 email during public forum on August 8, 2023.
4. At the August 8, 2023 Pawtucket Charter Review Commission meeting the Chair of the Pawtucket Charter Review Commission denied receipt of my, David C Fagnoli, August 3, 2023 email.
5. At the August 8, 2023 Pawtucket Charter Review Commission meeting the Chair of the Pawtucket Charter Review Commission denied my, David C Fagnoli, request to read my August 3, 2023 email during the, agenda posted, public forum portion of the meeting after denying receipt of my, David C Fagnoli, email.
6. The facts I stated in numbers 1 through 5 of this affidavit are/were violations to, Title 42/Chapter 46/Open Meetings/RI Gen Law 42-46-6(d), my, David C Fagnoli, rights, as a citizen, to have my August 3, 2023 email outreach of concerns either; read into the record, by the Chair of the Pawtucket Charter Review Commission, or, I, be allowed to speak to my concerns during the, agenda posted, open public forum segment of the August 8, 2023 Pawtucket Charter Review Commission meeting.


7. Violations by the City of Pawtucket, Title 42/Chapter 46/Open Meetings/RI Gen Law 42-46-6(b) in notice of agenda posting, regarding Pawtucket Charter Review Commissions meetings held on August 1, 2023 and August 2, 2023, by not providing sufficient agenda details regarding any topics or subjects which were/would be discussed, handled or voted on during these Charter Review Commission meetings, as required by RI Gen Law 42-46-6(b).
8. Violation by the City of Pawtucket, Title 42/Chapter 46/Open Meetings/ RI Gen Law 42-46-6(b) in filing notice of meeting agenda to the public with RI SOS, regarding the Pawtucket Charter Review Commissions meeting held on August 8, 2023, meeting agenda was not filed, with the RI SOS, 48 hours prior to the meeting, as required by RI Gen Law 42-46-6(b). (Aug 6, 2023 was a Sunday)
